



Code of Conduct

1. The use of mobiles is strictly prohibited on the entire campus including the hostels. However to meet emergencies, day scholars and hostellers are, on specific requests of their parents, allowed to keep basic models of mobiles deposited with the Security Personnel after signing in on arrival at college to be taken back at college closing time and with the hostel wardens respectively for use, if necessary and return between 8.00 pm and 8.30 pm in the case of boy residents and between 8.30 pm and 9.00 pm in the case of girl residents.
2. The use of FM radios and I pod in the college / college buses are also prohibited.
3. Students should be in their respective classes at least five minutes before the bell.
4. Students should be punctual, regular and attentive in both theory and practical classes.
5. Absolute silence should be maintained in the classes, laboratories and the library and while moving from one lecture hall to another.
6. Students should take all tests and submit all assignments and show good academic progress to the entire satisfaction of their respective teachers and HODs.
7. Unauthorized absence from classes / tests etc is punishable with fines as per procedures in practice. 28. Organizing meetings, collection of donations etc without the prior approval of the Principal for any purpose whatsoever is strictly prohibited.
8. Organized / mass absence or instigation to go on strikes / protests will be considered as a serious breach of discipline and may entail expulsion from the college.
9. No student is allowed to indulge in any anti-social, subversive activities or join any organization, association not connected with the college without the prior written permission of the Principal.
10. Formation of Unions / Associations based on caste, colour, creed, language, nationality, or political ideology within the campus is strictly forbidden.
11. Consumption of alcohol, drugs, smoking, on the campus is strictly prohibited and may result in expulsion from the college.

12. Students are responsible for the proper use and care of tools, apparatus, or other equipment given to them for purposes of study.
13. Causing damage to the college buildings, properties, furniture, equipment etc will entail heavy fines as well as compensations for damages from those responsible there for.
14. Students are strictly prohibited from making any payments of money, other than towards properly notified fees etc, to any official / authority of the college under any circumstances towards such purposes as 'placement' etc except when the Chairman issues an explicit notification to that effect under his official seal and signature. In all other cases, the Management of the college is not liable for any loss or other consequences suffered by students / parents owing to any unauthorized payments made.
15. Day scholar are not permitted to go to hostel.
