

FLOOD RELIEF

The 2015 South Indian Floods resulted from heavy rainfall generated by the annual northeast monsoon in November – December 2015. The City of Chennai particularly a hard hit. More than 500 people were killed and over 18 lakh people were displaced. 40 percent of the city's districts remained submerged and safe food and drinking water remained in short supply of basic necessities, including milk, water and vegetables were affected due to logistical difficulties. Apart from basic necessities, fuel supplies and travel were greatly affected over 1.5 lakh street vendors sustained losses of over 300 crore.

On that day, when the flood hit Chennai, the faculties and the students of Adhi College of Engineering and Technology rushed to Tambaram, with much difficulty, they reached that spot and found a lot of people, were deserted only with the dress worn on.
