The grievances include

- g) Remedial/ Co-Curricular coaching for skill development, writing an assignment making presentation in class, public speaking, job selection and Job interviews.
- h) To conduct special coaching classes using SCP funds provided exclusively for the welfare of SC/ST students

- i) To offer book bank facility semester wise
- j) Any other forms of grievances to be redressed
